
- Independent European group of scientists

Prize of the Academy

The European Academy of Rehabilitation
 Medicine has created an annual prize .This is
 funded by the Journal of Rehabilitation
 Medicine and the non-profit Foundation for
 Rehabilitation Information (Sweden)

 The prize is 1200 Euros plus up to 450 Euros for registration, travelling and accommodation at the occasion when the prize is presented.

Prize of the Academy

- A submission should be on a rehabilitation, physical medicine or medico-social topic relating to the (re-) integration of persons with disabilities
- It should be the work of a doctor or health professional employed in a Physical and Rehabilitation Department of a country which has an official delegate in the Physical and Rehabilitation Medicine Section of European Union of Medical Specialists.(www.euro-prm.org)
- The work should be written in one of the two official languages of the Academy (English or French).
